Personal journal, to be written in frequently - preferably no smaller than 8"x6"

Please also follow the required supply list for middle school, and have those things **with you in your zipper pouch AT ALL TIMES (pens, pencils, colored pencils (those can stay in your locker until a teacher asks you to bring them), glue stick, scissors, erasers, highlighters, pencil sharpener).
