

## **Clintonville Academy – Regulations for Riding the School Bus**

So that you will understand the rules covering the conduct of your child(ren) when riding the school bus during gym class or for school field trips, you and your child(ren) should read these regulations together. Once you have read over the regulations, please initial the “Consolidated Permission Form” and return to school to indicate that you give consent and understand these regulations. Please keep this form for your records.

### **REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS RIDING THE SCHOOL BUS**

Drivers are responsible for and shall expect orderly conduct of students. Students on the bus shall be under the authority of and directly responsible to the driver. If students do not respond to the driver’s request for such orderly conduct, the driver shall report this to the Director. Appropriate disciplinary action may be taken as determined by the Director.

#### **THE FOLLOWING IS PROHIBITED:**

1. Excessive noise, loud talking, yelling.
2. Noise or other distracting noises at railroad crossings, or other danger point.
3. Putting ANY part of the body or object through an open window.
4. Throwing any object in the bus or out of a window.
5. Fighting or “roughhousing”.
6. Not remaining seated.
7. Eating, drinking, chewing gum, or littering.
8. Transporting animals, pets, or any dangerous object.
9. Transporting any glass container.
10. Any act of vandalism.
11. Use of profane or objectionable language.
12. Failure to comply with the driver, teacher, or school appointed chaperone.

Failure to comply with these regulations, in addition to the bus driver’s rules for safety and common courtesy, will result in disciplinary action.
